**Minutes of the Annual CertiLingua Conference 2009  
in Eltville/ Hesse**

Votes of the Annual CertiLingua Conference  
of 17<sup>th</sup> May 2009

The third international annual conference of the CertiLingua label of excellence for plurilingual, European and international competences was held in Eltville, Hesse, from 15<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> May 2009, hosted by the Hessian Ministry of Culture. 37 representatives from the 11 partner countries (France, Italy, the Netherlands, Austria and the German states of Berlin, Hesse, Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania, Lower Saxony, North Rhine-Westphalia Rhineland-Palatinate, Saxony, and Thuringia), and 3 further countries (Baden-Württemberg, Poland and the Czech Republic) participated in the conference which also marked the official end of the pilot phase. The conference focused on agreements of how best to continue with the project in the future.

The reports from the partner countries show that first results about CertiLingua's impact on school development can already be deduced from in the pilot phase, in particular as far as the advancement of multilingualism, activity-based language learning, and the development of specific European and international competences is concerned. All in all, the CertiLingua label of excellence proved to be a motivation for students to fully exploit the learning opportunities in languages, CLIL and international affairs their schools provide. The participating schools appreciate the label of excellence as a proof of their efforts to provide their students with international learning opportunities. International companies, universities and institutions are helping CertiLingua to gain further recognition and support. A detailed final report on the pilot phase is going to be available soon. The practical implementation of the three competences (linguistic, bilingual, European and international competences) was discussed in the workgroups and agreements were reached concerning the label's future development, expansion and recognition. The suggestions from the workgroups will be collected by the international steering group and prepared to be voted on at the next annual conference in Eupen, Belgium, in 2010. Resolutions 2009-01 to 2009-04 and 2009-06 to 2009-13 are unanimously accepted by the annual conference in their given form with 14 votes.
